Monday - Saturday: 10am - 5pm

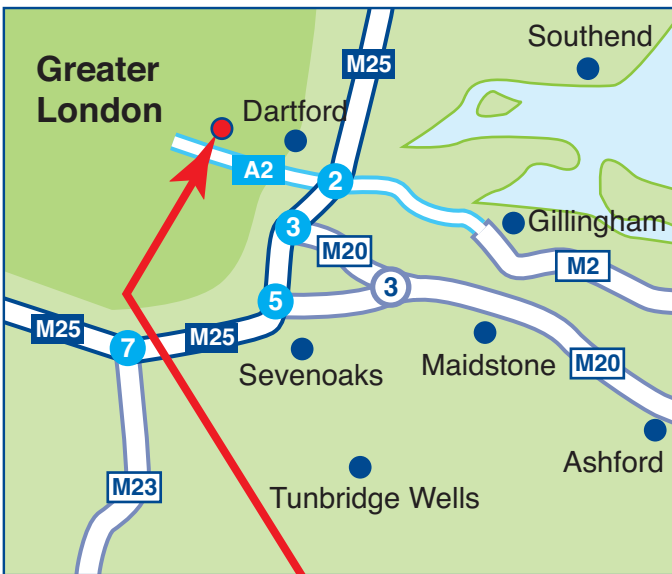
Sundays and Bank Holidays: 11am - 5pm

It boasts a magnificent panelled Great Hall and Minstrels Gallery. The house is situated in formal award winning gardens overlooking the River Cray. The gardens provide a beautiful setting for your wedding photographs.



The Great Hall and the Drawing Room are both sanctioned for civil ceremonies, either for the more intimate service of up to 40 or for the larger group of up to 100.

The house is a Grade 1 listed building, which offers an opportunity for a ceremony at an unusual and stunning venue.

- Confirm your booking by returning your completed booking form and terms and conditions along with the 50% non refundable deposit.
